

CONFESSIONS

Instructions: Speak the “confession” out loud. Confession means to speak out loud verbally.

For in Him we live, and move, and have our being...” (Acts 17:28)

Confession: In Him I live ... and move ... and have my being! What a vast storehouse of power! In Christ my Savior and Lord I have life! ... Energy! Strength for the impossible tasks!

“I am the vine, ye are the branches. If ye abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.” (John 15:5a, 7)

Confession: I abide in Him. I live in Him. He is the vine – I am the branch. The vine is in the branch – and the branch in the vine. His Life – the Life of God – is in me. His nature – the Love nature – is in me. Just as blood flows through my natural body, His Life flows through my inner man. I will let that Life and Love dominate me.

“Therefore, if any man be in Christ, he is a new creation: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.” (II Corinthians 5:17)

Confession: I am a new creature in Christ Jesus. I am a new creation being, with the Life of God, the nature of God, and the ability of God within me.

“For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus.” (Ephesians 2:10)

Confession: I am His workmanship. He made me a new creation.

“For he hath made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.” (II Corinthians 5:21)

Confession: I am the righteousness of God in Christ. My standing with God is secure. My prayers avail much.

“There is therefore now no condemnation to them who are in Christ Jesus...”
(Romans 8:1)

Confession: Because I am in Christ Jesus, right now, present tense, there is no sense of condemnation about me.

“But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption.” (I Corinthians 1:30)

Confession: Christ Jesus, my Lord, is my wisdom. He is my righteousness. He is my sanctification. He is my redemption.

“For if by one man’s offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace, and the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one Jesus Christ.” (Romans 5:17)

Confession: I have received abundance of grace and the gift of righteousness. I reign as a king in my domain in this life through Jesus Christ.

“Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son: In Whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins.” (Colossians 1:13-14)

“In Whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace.” (Ephesians 1:7)

Confession: I HAVE redemption through Jesus! It is settled.

“Who His own self bare sins in His own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: By Whose stripes ye were healed.” (I Peter 2:24)

“... Himself took our infirmities and bare our sicknesses.” (Matthew 8:17)

Confession: By His stripes I was healed! God's Word tells me I was healed almost 2000 years ago by His stripes. If I was healed, then I am healed. Healing belongs to me because I am in Christ.

"For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death." (Romans 8:2)

Confession: The law of life in Christ Jesus has set me free from the law of sin and death.

"Resist the devil, and he will flee from you." (James 4:7)

Confession: I resist the devil and he WILL flee from me. He will run from me as if in terror. God has already done all He is going to do about it. He sent Jesus and Jesus arose victorious over the devil. Jesus defeated him for me. And now it is my turn to do something about it. You can because you are "in Him". When you find out what your rights and privileges are in Christ, when you find out the Name of Jesus belongs to you, when he knows you have learned what that Name will do, then he will run from you as if in terror.

"Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world." (1 John 4:4)

Confession: Because I am in Christ, the Greater One lives in me. He is Greater than the devil. Greater than disease. Greater than circumstances. And He lives in me! God is in me now!! The Master of Creation is in me.

"Nay, in all these things, we are more than conquerors through Him that loved us." (Romans 8:37)

Confession: I am a conqueror! I am not afraid of any circumstances, disease, or condition. I face life fearlessly.

“I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me.” (Philippians 4:13)

Confession: Through Christ, my Lord, I can do all things. He strengthens me. I cannot be conquered. I cannot be defeated. I can do all things through Him. I do not look to flesh and natural human reasoning. That limits me to my own ability. The Bible says nothing about being strong in myself. It says that God is our strength.

“I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet now I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me.”

Confession: I am crucified with Christ. I don't have to try to do it. I am crucified with Christ. Yet, nevertheless I live! And Christ lives in me!

“Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to His saints: To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.” (Colossians 1:26-27)

Confession: Christ lives in me!

“And you hath he quickened (made alive), who were dead in trespasses and sins; ... But God, who is rich in mercy, for His great love wherewith He loved us, even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, and hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus.” (Ephesians 2:1, 4-6)

Confession: I was crucified with Christ. When He was quickened and made alive – I was quickened with Him. I was raised up together with Him and made to sit together with Him in heavenly places. Today, positionally, I am sealed with Christ in heavenly places.

“But my God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.” (Philippians 4:19)

“Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ.” (Ephesians 1:3)

Confession: He has already blessed me! Everything I need, He has already blessed me with it.
