
FORGIVENESS IS NOT

- simply trying to forget.
- just letting time pass after an offense.
- disregarding the wrong another person has done to you.
- pretending that an offense didn't matter.


HURTS & OFFENSES

- one-time offenses or repeated wrongs done to you
- The person who offended you may or may not know that you were hurt.
- The person who offended you may or may not be living.




HOW I WAS WRONGED




HOW I FELT

GOD'S FORGIVENESS OF SIN

- He doesn't pretend that you haven't sinned.
- He doesn't ignore your sin.
- He doesn't act like your sin doesn't matter.

INSTEAD - God sent His Only Son, Jesus, to pay for your sin.

A BLOOD SACRIFICE IS REQUIRED FOR THE FORGIVENESS OF SIN

"...Without the shedding of blood, there is no forgiveness of sins." Hebrews 9:22 (NLT)

JESUS BECAME THE COMPLETE PAYMENT FOR SIN

"Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"

John 1:29 (NKJ)

YOUR OFFENDER...

- May still need to receive God's forgiveness
- May still be held legally responsible for what was done

BUT...as far as you are concerned, they are no longer guilty.

"Then the king called in the man he had forgiven and said, 'You evil servant! I FORGAVE YOU that tremendous debt because you pleaded with me. Shouldn't you have mercy on your fellow servant, just as I had mercy on you?'

Then the angry king sent the man to PRISON until he had paid every penny. 'That's what my heavenly Father will do to you IF YOU REFUSE TO FORGIVE your brothers and sisters in your heart." Matthew 18:32-35 (NLT)




TRUE FORGIVENESS IS ...

CHOOSING to accept the blood of Jesus as the full payment for what your offender did.




"Be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven YOU." Ephesians 4:32 (NLT)


4 BARS OF THE PRISON




4 KEYS IN YOUR HAND



KEY #1 FORGIVE WHAT THEY DID




KEY #2 FORGIVE THE EMOTIONS



- Do everything you can to make restitution


