Though God has the power to control, the right to judge, and deserves all praise, there are others who have tried to take these rights.

#### It started with Satan.



"How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer...you have said in your heart: 'I will



ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation on the farthest sides of the north; I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High." Isaiah 14:12–14 (NKJ)

"I will ascend into heaven."

He wants to take *control* and do what he pleases.

"I will sit on the mount of the congregation."

He wants to rule and judge from a seat of authority.

"I will exalt my throne."

He wants people to bow at his throne and *praise* him.

#### Satan Tries to Be Like God.

Trying to be like God did not end with Satan. Satan (in the form of a serpent) successfully tempted Adam and Eve to

follow his rebellion of trying to be like God.

#### Man Tries to Be Like God!

Adam and Eve chose to follow Satan in trying to be like God, rather than acknowledging God as God and obeying Him.

That pattern of behavior passed to all mankind.






