

Prayer for God's Help, Protection, and Deliverance (Psalm 35)

Heavenly Father,

I come before You today in the mighty name of Jesus Christ, my Savior, my Redeemer, and my Deliverer. I humble myself before Your throne of grace, acknowledging that apart from You, I am weak, vulnerable, and unable to stand against the battles that rage against my soul. Yet, I thank You, Lord, that You are my Defender, my Shield, my Fortress, and my Avenger. You are the One who fights for me, the One who delivers me, and the One who has already given me victory through the cross of Jesus Christ.

Lord, before I ask for Your intervention, I bow in repentance. I confess that I have sinned and fallen short of Your glory. Forgive me for every word, thought, and deed that has grieved Your Spirit. Forgive me for pride, unbelief, fear, anger, and disobedience. Wash me in the precious blood of Jesus and cleanse me from all unrighteousness. I lay my heart bare before You, asking that You create in me a clean heart and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

Father, I also choose this day to release forgiveness to those who have wounded me. I will not hold bitterness, resentment, or vengeance in my heart, for Your Word says that vengeance belongs to You alone. I forgive those who have spoken lies about me, those who have plotted against me, those who rejoice at my pain, and those who secretly desire my downfall. I let them go, Lord, and I place them in Your hands. I choose to bless rather than curse, to release rather than retaliate, and to love as Christ has loved me.

But now, Lord, I lift up my cry to You as David did. Plead my cause, O Lord, with those who strive against me. Fight against those who fight against me. Rise up with Your shield and buckler, and stand up for my help. Draw out Your spear and

stop those who pursue me. Speak to my soul and reassure me: “I am your salvation.” Let Your voice be louder than the accusations of the enemy and the mockery of my adversaries.

Father, let those who seek after my life be put to shame and dishonor. Let those who plot my hurt be turned back and brought to confusion. Let them be like chaff before the wind, chased away by the angel of the Lord. Make their way dark and slippery, and let Your mighty hand pursue them until their plans are destroyed. Lord, they have dug pits and laid nets for me without cause, but I ask that their own traps would ensnare them. Let sudden destruction come upon them, and may their devices turn back upon their own heads.

Lord, in the midst of these battles, I declare that my soul shall be joyful in You. I will rejoice in Your salvation, for You are the God who delivers the poor from those too strong for them, the needy from those who plunder them. Who is like You, O Lord? None can compare to Your power, Your mercy, and Your faithfulness.

Father, You see how fierce witnesses rise up against me, how false accusations are spoken, and how evil is rewarded for my good. My soul has known sorrow because of betrayal and cruelty. Yet, I remember how I prayed for those who now rise against me. I mourned for them when they suffered, I interceded for them, and I humbled myself in fasting. But they repay me with mockery, with gnashing teeth, and with joy over my pain.

O Lord, how long will You look on? Rescue me from their destructions. Deliver my soul from the lions who seek to devour me. Save me from the snares of the wicked and the schemes of the enemy. Do not allow them to triumph over me, O God. Do not let them say in their hearts, “We have swallowed him up.” Do not let them rejoice over me, for You are my Defender and my Justifier.

Lord, arise in Your righteousness. Stir Yourself for my vindication. Awake to my cause, my God and my Lord. Vindicate me according to Your righteousness, not because I am worthy, but because of the blood of Jesus that speaks better things than the blood of Abel. Silence the mouths of those who accuse me falsely. Confuse the plans of those who devise deceit against the quiet ones of the land. Let shame and dishonor cover those who exalt themselves against me. But let those who favor my righteous cause rejoice and shout for joy. Let them continually declare, “Let the Lord be magnified, who has pleasure in the prosperity of His servant.”

Father, I know that the true battle is not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, powers, rulers of darkness, and spiritual wickedness in high places. Therefore, I put on the whole armor of God. I take up the shield of faith, the helmet of salvation, the breastplate of righteousness, the belt of truth, the shoes of the gospel of peace, and the sword of the Spirit, which is Your Word. I stand strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. No weapon formed against me shall prosper, and every tongue that rises against me in judgment I condemn, for this is my heritage as a servant of the Lord, and my righteousness is from You.

I declare, O God, that You are my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear? You are the strength of my life—of whom shall I be afraid? Though an army may encamp against me, my heart shall not fear, for You are with me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil, and my cup runs over. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

Father, I thank You that my cry does not fall on deaf ears. You are near to the brokenhearted and save those who are crushed in spirit. You hear the cry of the righteous, and Your ears are attentive to their prayer. I know that even now, as I lift my voice, You are moving on my behalf. Angels are being dispatched. Strongholds are being broken. The enemy is being scattered. And victory is being secured in the mighty name of Jesus.

So I choose this day to trust You, Lord. I choose to rest in Your faithfulness. I choose to worship You in the midst of the storm. I choose to exalt Your name above every fear, every enemy, and every weapon that has been formed against me. My tongue shall speak of Your righteousness and of Your praise all the day long.

Father, let Your kingdom come and let Your will be done in my life as it is in heaven. Be glorified in my deliverance. Be magnified in my restoration. And may my life be a testimony of Your power to save, protect, and deliver.

I seal this prayer in the precious blood of Jesus Christ, and I declare that it is done.
