

The Power of the Blood Covenant: Living in the Victory of the Cross and Resurrection

The death and resurrection of Jesus Christ are not just historical events — they are the foundation of a covenant sealed in His own blood. Many people remember Good Friday and Easter as religious traditions, but the truth runs deeper. The Last Supper, the Cross, the empty tomb, and Christ's forty days of resurrection appearances all reveal a divine covenant that still speaks life, healing, and deliverance to us today.

This covenant is not just for the first disciples; it is for everyone who believes in Christ throughout every generation. Let's explore the mystery of the Blood Covenant, the victory of the resurrection, and what it means for us today.

1. The Blood Covenant Revealed at the Last Supper

On the night before His crucifixion, Jesus sat with His disciples for what we call The Last Supper. This was during the Passover celebration, where Israel remembered the lamb's blood on the doorposts in Egypt that spared them from death (Exodus 12). But Jesus revealed that He Himself was the true Passover Lamb.

Luke 22:19-20 (NKJV)

"And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, 'This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me.' Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you.'"

The bread represented His body, soon to be broken for us.

The cup represented His blood, poured out for the forgiveness of sins.

This was not just a ritual — it was the beginning of a covenant sealed by His sacrifice.

No longer would animal sacrifices be necessary. The blood of bulls and goats could never truly remove sin (Hebrews 10:4), but the blood of Jesus cleanses us completely.

2. The Veil Was Torn: Access to God Restored

When Jesus gave up His spirit on the cross, something supernatural happened.

Matthew 27:50-53 (NKJV)

“And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and yielded up His spirit. Then, behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; and the earth quaked, and the rocks were split, and the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised; and coming out of the graves after His resurrection, they went into the holy city and appeared to many.”

The torn veil meant:

No more separation between God and man.

We now have direct access to the Father through Christ’s blood.

Resurrection power began breaking forth immediately, even opening graves!

This shows that the Blood Covenant doesn’t just cover sin — it destroys death and ushers in new life.

3. Jesus Appears in Resurrection Glory

For forty days after rising from the dead, Jesus appeared to His disciples and many others.

Acts 1:3 (NKJV)

“To whom He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God.”

He appeared to Mary Magdalene (John 20:11-18).

He appeared to the disciples on the road to Emmaus, opening the Scriptures to them and revealing Himself when He broke bread (Luke 24:30-32).

He appeared to Thomas, showing His wounds (John 20:27-28).

He gave the Great Commission to the apostles (Matthew 28:18-20).

Every encounter confirmed that Jesus was alive and that His Blood Covenant had established a new reality: the Kingdom of God was now breaking into the earth.

4. The Covenant of Healing and Deliverance

The Blood Covenant is not just about forgiveness; it includes healing and deliverance.

Isaiah 53:4-5 (NKJV)

“Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.”

1 Peter 2:24 (NKJV)

“Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.”

Notice: “you were healed” — past tense. Healing is part of the covenant already secured by Christ.

This means:

You can receive forgiveness of sin through His blood.

You can receive healing for your body through His stripes.

You can receive peace of mind and freedom from torment because He carried your sorrows.

5. Living in the Covenant Today

The danger for many believers is to stop at the crucifixion and never move into resurrection power. Just like the disciples on the road to Emmaus, our eyes can be closed until we truly encounter Him.

Jesus doesn't just want you to believe He died; He wants you to walk in His risen life.

He longs to break bread with you in fellowship and reveal Himself in fresh ways.

He invites you into a deeper walk where His covenant power transforms your daily life.

John 10:10 (NKJV)

"The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly."

The Blood Covenant is not only about eternal salvation — it's about abundant life in Christ here and now.

6. Our Response to the Blood Covenant

To walk in the fullness of this covenant:

Believe in the finished work of the cross and resurrection.

Receive forgiveness and cleansing through His blood.

Remember His sacrifice through communion with a heart of faith.

Walk in the authority of the covenant, declaring His promises over your life.

Share the good news with others, just as the apostles did after their encounters with Him.

Closing Prayer

Heavenly Father,

I declare today: By His stripes I am healed. By His blood I am redeemed. By His resurrection I am alive with Him forevermore.
