The Great Exchange: Jesus Took Our Place

1. Jesus Took Our Place in Sin


From Adam's fall onward, sin has stained every human soul. The law was clear:


"The soul who sins shall die." (Ezekiel 18:4, NKJV)

Healing is not a hopeful wish—it is covenant inheritance for the believer.

4. Jesus Took Our Place in Death

Sin's final weapon is death itself.

"Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin..." (Romans 5:12, NKJV)


But Jesus shattered its power:

"...that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage." (Hebrews 2:14–15, NKJV)

Death could not hold Him because He had no sin of His own. He borrowed death, broke it open, and walked out victorious.

5. Jesus Took Our Place in Condemnation

All judgment fell on Him so we could go free.



He wore a crown of thorns so we could wear the crown of life. (James 1:12) Every injustice He suffered was in our place. walking in freedom, authority, and victory.
