HOW TO LIVE FOR GOD IN THE END-TIMES

A Practical, Biblical Manual for Remaining Faithful, Holy, and Unmovable

SECTION 1 — YOU ARE CALLED, SANCTIFIED, AND PRESERVED

Scripture Foundation (NKJV):

“Jude, a bondservant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James,
To those who are called, sanctified by God the Father, and
preserved in Jesus Christ:

Mercy, peace, and love be multiplied to you.” — **Jude 1:1–2**

From the opening lines of the **Epistle of Jude**, God establishes identity *before* instruction. You are not introduced as weak, confused, or endangered—you are introduced as **kept**.

You are:

- **Called** — chosen, summoned, and appointed by God
- **Sanctified** — set apart for holy purposes
- **Preserved** — guarded and sustained in Jesus Christ

End-times living always begins with identity. When believers forget who they are, they begin to imitate the world rather than confront it.

Key Truths:

- You are not abandoned in the last days
- You are not powerless in dark times

- You are not meant to fear, but to stand firm

Call to Action:

Stop living like a survivor and start living like the preserved. Walk daily with confidence that God Himself is keeping you.

Section Summary:

Before you face deception, persecution, or pressure, you must settle your identity. You are not barely holding on—you are divinely preserved. End-times victory starts with knowing who you belong to.

SECTION 2 — CONTEND FOR THE FAITH WITHOUT COMPROMISE

Scripture Foundation (NKJV):

Call to Action:

Examine what you believe. If it excuses sin, rejects repentance, or minimizes obedience—it is not biblical faith.

Section Summary:

The end-times demand courage, not convenience. You are called to defend truth lovingly but boldly. Compromise may be popular, but contending for the faith is commanded.

SECTION 3 — LEARN FROM JUDGMENT, NOT JUST MERCY

Scripture Foundation (NKJV):

“The Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed those who did not believe.” — **Jude 1:5**

call light darkness or darkness light. Teach me to tremble at Your Word again. Plant in me a deep reverence for Your holiness, knowing that You are both Savior and Judge, merciful and just.

Lord, remind my soul of Your righteous judgments. As You delivered Israel yet judged unbelief, as You judged angels who abandoned their proper domain, as You judged Sodom and Gomorrah for rebellion and perversion—let these warnings produce **godly fear**, not terror, but reverence that keeps me walking uprightly before You. Preserve me from presumption. Deliver me from thinking that yesterday's obedience guarantees today's faithfulness. Teach me to endure, to persevere, to remain faithful until the end.

Father, cleanse me from every work of the flesh. I renounce rebellion, pride, sensuality, lawlessness, and self-will. I refuse to reject authority or speak evil of what I do not understand. Teach me humility, like Michael the archangel, who trusted not in his own power but said, "*The Lord rebuke you.*" Let my confidence rest in You alone. Guard my tongue. Guard my thoughts. Guard my motives. Let me not walk in the way of Cain, nor chase the greed of Balaam, nor perish in the rebellion of Korah. Root out every seed of envy, ambition, and self-exaltation from my heart.

Lord, keep me from becoming fruitless, empty, or spiritually barren. I do not want to be a cloud without water, a tree without fruit, or a wandering star. I want to be planted by Your Spirit, rooted deeply in truth, bearing fruit in season, full of life and power. Fill me afresh with the Holy Spirit. Build me up on my **most holy faith**. Teach me how to pray in the Spirit with purity, endurance, and power. Let my prayer life not be routine but alive, intimate, and transformative.

Father, help me to **keep myself in the love of God**. When trials increase, when mockers arise, when pressure mounts, do not let my love grow cold. Fix my eyes on the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. Keep eternity before me. Let me live today in light of that day when You come with ten thousands of Your saints to execute judgment and to establish righteousness forever.

Lord, shape my heart toward others. Give me compassion with discernment. Teach me when to show mercy gently and when to rescue with holy urgency. Make me bold enough to pull others from the fire, yet pure enough to hate even the garment defiled by the flesh. Protect me from contamination while using me as a vessel of deliverance, truth, and restoration.

Above all, faithful God, I place my confidence in You—not in myself. You are **able to keep me from stumbling**. You are able to present me **faultless before the presence of Your glory with exceeding joy**. I trust You to finish the work You began in me. I trust You to preserve me in sound doctrine, in obedience, in holiness, and in faithfulness until the very end.

To You, **God our Savior**, who alone is wise—
be glory and majesty,
dominion and power,
both now and forever.

I seal this prayer in the mighty, faithful, and unchanging name of **Jesus Christ**,
Amen.
