

REMEMBER LOT'S WIFE

A Biblical Warning from Jesus (Luke 17:32) about the Danger of Looking Back at the Sinful Past When God Calls You to Move Forward

SECTION 1 — THE WORD OF JESUS THAT STOPS US MID-STEP

Luke 17:32 (NKJV):

“Remember Lot’s wife.”

These three words came from the mouth of **Jesus Christ**, spoken in the context of judgment, urgency, and the revealing of the Son of Man. They are not poetic. They are not symbolic filler. They are a command—sharp, direct, and sobering.

Jesus did not say, *“Study Lot’s wife.”*

He did not say, *“Analyze Lot’s wife.”*

He said, **“REMEMBER.”**

To remember is to carry a warning forward. It means this is not a dead story—it is a living message. Jesus deliberately reached back into Genesis to pull one woman’s decision into the future of every believer who would ever follow Him.

Lot’s wife is not remembered because she lived wickedly—but because she **hesitated when God said flee.**

Summary – Why This Still Matters

Jesus warned future believers that the greatest danger would not always be open rebellion—but **divided obedience**. Remembering Lot’s wife is remembering that delayed obedience, backward glances, and emotional attachment to the old life can be fatal to spiritual progress.

SECTION 2 — THE MERCY THAT PULLED LOT OUT

Genesis 19:16 (NKJV):

“And while he lingered, the men took hold of his hand, his wife’s hand, and the hands of his two daughters, the LORD being merciful to him, and they brought him out and set him outside the city.”

Sodom was not destroyed suddenly. God warned first. He sent messengers. He offered mercy before judgment.

Lot lingered. His family hesitated. Yet mercy still grabbed them.

This teaches us:

- God’s judgment is never impulsive
- God always provides a way of escape
- Mercy often moves us **before we are emotionally ready**

Lot’s wife was physically removed from danger—but her heart was still inside the city.

Summary – Mercy Moves Faster Than Feelings

God’s mercy often outruns our emotions. The danger is not refusing to leave—it is **leaving physically while remaining emotionally attached** to what God is destroying.

SECTION 3 — THE COMMAND THAT COULD NOT BE NEGOTIATED

Genesis 19:17 (NKJV):

“Escape for your life! Do not look behind you nor stay anywhere in the plain. Escape to the mountains, lest you be destroyed.”

This was not advice. It was not suggestion. It was survival instruction.

Three commands:

- **Escape**
- **Do not look back**
- **Do not stop**

Looking back was forbidden because **looking back would re-attach the heart.**

Summary – Partial Obedience Is Still Disobedience

When God says “*Do not look back,*” He is not being harsh—He is being protective. What He destroys must not be sentimentalized.

SECTION 4 — THE LOOK THAT COST HER EVERYTHING

Genesis 19:26 (NKJV):

“But his wife looked back behind him, and she became a pillar of salt.”

This was not a casual glance. This was longing.

Her body moved forward—but her heart turned backward.

Salt preserves—but it also **immobilizes**. She became a monument of frozen indecision.

Summary – What You Look At Determines What You Become

What you turn toward emotionally will determine whether you move forward spiritually. Looking back arrests progress.

SECTION 5 — WHY JESUS BROUGHT HER UP AGAIN

Luke 17:28–30 (NKJV):

“Likewise as it was also in the days of Lot... Even so will it be in the day when the Son of Man is revealed.”

Jesus ties Lot’s wife to:

- End-time urgency
- Sudden judgment
- No time for divided loyalty

Summary – Judgment Requires Undivided Focus

When God says “*Now*,” hesitation becomes dangerous. Spiritual delay can become spiritual loss.

SECTION 6 — PRESERVING YOUR LIFE BY LOSING IT

Luke 17:33 (NKJV):

“Whoever seeks to save his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life will preserve it.”

Trying to preserve the old life always costs the new one.

Summary – Letting Go Is How You Live

What you refuse to release will eventually restrain you.

SECTION 7 — NO LOOKING BACK IN THE KINGDOM

Luke 9:62 (NKJV):

“No one, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.”

Kingdom work requires **forward vision**.

Summary – Forward Call Requires Forward Eyes

You cannot plow forward while staring backward.

SECTION 8 — THE MODERN APPLICATION

Lot’s wife represents:

- Old sins
- Old relationships
- Old identities
- Old comforts
- Old compromises

Summary – Deliverance Requires Detachment

Freedom only lasts when attachment is broken.

SECTION 9 — GOD IS CALLING YOU OUT, NOT BACK

This teaching is not about fear—it is about **freedom**.

God is not punishing you by calling you forward.
He is **saving you**.

Summary – Forward Is Where Life Is

Your future cannot coexist with what God already judged.

CLOSING CALL TO ACTION

Do not negotiate with what God has told you to leave.
Do not romanticize what God rescued you from.
Do not look back.

Remember Lot's wife—and choose life.

CLOSING PRAYER

Father in the name of Jesus Christ,

I come before You with a surrendered heart and open hands. I thank You for Your mercy that reached into my life while I was lingering, hesitating, and unsure. Lord, You were faithful to pull me out of what would have destroyed me—even when my heart was still conflicted.

Today, I choose obedience over attachment.

I repent for every time I looked back emotionally at what You delivered me from. I repent for longing for old habits, old comforts, old identities, and old sins. I confess that there have been moments where my feet were moving forward but my heart was turning backward. Forgive me, Lord.

In the name of Jesus, I renounce every tie to my former life that competes with Your call. I renounce nostalgia for bondage. I renounce emotional attachment to sin. I renounce fear of the unknown that keeps me tied to the familiar.

Lord, I ask You to sever every soul-tie, memory-tie, emotional tie, and spiritual tie that tries to pull me back into what You have already judged and destroyed. I declare that my past no longer has permission to speak to my future.

Father, give me eyes to look forward.
Give me strength to keep moving.
Give me grace to obey quickly.

I declare that I will not be a pillar of salt—immobilized by hesitation. I will not be frozen between Egypt and the Promised Land. I choose life. I choose freedom. I choose obedience.

Jesus, You said that whoever loses their life for Your sake will preserve it. Today, I willingly lay down my old life. I release my grip on what once defined me. I trust You with what is ahead of me.

Holy Spirit, empower me to walk forward without regret. Guard my heart when memories try to pull me backward. Strengthen my resolve when temptation whispers familiarity. Anchor me in truth when emotions rise.

I declare that my best days are not behind me—they are ahead of me. I will not look back. I will not stop in the plain. I will escape fully into Your will.

Thank You, Lord, for rescuing me.
Thank You for warning me.
Thank You for leading me forward.

I remember Lot's wife—
and I choose obedience.
