

# THE POWER IN KNOWING WHO YOU ARE IN CHRIST

*A Discipleship & Freedom Manual*

## SECTION 1: Identity Begins With God’s Truth, Not Your Feelings

Knowing who you are in Christ begins with **where truth comes from**. Feelings fluctuate. Culture redefines. Circumstances deceive. But God’s Word remains eternal and authoritative. Identity is not discovered through self-exploration—it is **received through divine revelation**.

- Your identity is **revealed by God**, not created by you
- Feelings describe your **condition**, not your **position**
- Truth stabilizes you when emotions are unstable

### Scripture (NKJV):

“Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.” — John 17:17

“Forever, O Lord, Your word is settled in heaven.” — Psalm 119:89

When your life is anchored in truth, you stop reacting to emotions and start walking in redemption. Satan traffics in lies; God establishes freedom through truth.

### Summary:

Your identity must be rooted in God’s unchanging Word—not emotions, opinions, or past experiences.

**65. Saved by faith — Romans 10:9 (NKJV)**

“That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.”

**66. Mind of Christ — 1 Corinthians 2:16 (NKJV)**

“For ‘who has known the mind of the LORD that he may instruct Him?’ But we have the mind of Christ.”

**67. Member of Christ's body — 1 Corinthians 12:27 (NKJV)**

“Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually.”

**68. Eternally prepared — 2 Corinthians 5:5 (NKJV)**

“Now He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who also has given us the Spirit as a guarantee.”

**69. Set free — Galatians 5:1 (NKJV)**

“Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.”

**70. Flesh crucified — Galatians 5:24 (NKJV)**

“And those who are Christ’s have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.”

**71. Created righteous — Ephesians 4:24 (NKJV)**

“And that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.”

**72. Light in darkness — Philippians 2:15 (NKJV)**

“That you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world.”

**73. Supplied by God — Philippians 4:19 (NKJV)**

“And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.”

**74. Reconciled — Colossians 1:22 (NKJV)**

“In the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight.”

**75. Loved and chosen — 1 Thessalonians 1:4 (NKJV)**

“Knowing, beloved brethren, your election by God.”

**76. Led by the Lord — Deuteronomy 31:8 (NKJV)**

“And the LORD, He is the One who goes before you. He will be with you, He will not leave you nor forsake you; do not fear nor be dismayed.”

**77. Strong and courageous — Joshua 1:9 (NKJV)**

“Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.”

**78. Shepherded by God — Psalm 23:1 (NKJV)**

“The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.”

**79. Fearless in Christ — Psalm 27:1 (NKJV)**

“The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?  
The LORD is the strength of my life;  
Of whom shall I be afraid?”

**80. Hidden and protected — Psalm 32:7 (NKJV)**

“You are my hiding place; You shall preserve me from trouble;  
You shall surround me with songs of deliverance. Selah”

**81. Never without help — Psalm 46:1 (NKJV)**

“God is our refuge and strength,  
A very present help in trouble.”

**82. Sheltered by God — Psalm 91:1 (NKJV)**

“He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High  
Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.”

**83. Forgiven and healed — Psalm 103:3 (NKJV)**

“Who forgives all your iniquities,  
Who heals all your diseases.”

**84. Upheld by God — Isaiah 41:10 (NKJV)**

“Fear not, for I am with you;  
Be not dismayed, for I am your God.  
I will strengthen you,  
Yes, I will help you,  
I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.”

**85. Clothed in salvation — Isaiah 61:10 (NKJV)**

“I will greatly rejoice in the LORD,  
My soul shall be joyful in my God;  
For He has clothed me with the garments of salvation,  
He has covered me with the robe of righteousness.”

**86. Deeply valued — Matthew 6:26 (NKJV)**

“Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?”

**87. Will shine in God’s Kingdom — Matthew 13:43 (NKJV)**

“Then the righteous will shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears to hear, let him hear!”

**88. Backed by Christ’s authority — Matthew 28:18 (NKJV)**

“And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, ‘All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.’”

**89. Given the Kingdom — Luke 12:32 (NKJV)**

“Do not fear, little flock, for it is your Father’s good pleasure to give you the kingdom.”

**90. Fully satisfied — John 6:35 (NKJV)**

“And Jesus said to them, ‘I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.’”

**91. Alive forever — John 11:25 (NKJV)**

“Jesus said to her, ‘I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live.’”

**92. Branch in the Vine — John 15:5 (NKJV)**

“I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.”

**93. Declared righteous — Acts 13:39 (NKJV)**

“And by Him everyone who believes is justified from all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses.”

**94. Filled with joy — Romans 4:7 (NKJV)**

“Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven,  
And whose sins are covered.”

**95. Alive by the Spirit — Romans 8:11 (NKJV)**

“But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.”

**96. Transformed by truth — Romans 12:2 (NKJV)**

“And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.”

**97. Called holy — 1 Corinthians 1:2 (NKJV)**

“To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ our Lord.”

**98. Victorious through Christ — 1 Corinthians 15:57 (NKJV)**

“But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.”
