

Teaching Title: “Heaven's Healing Promise: Accessing Divine Health Through the Blood of Jesus”

Page 1: The Healing Covenant—Bought by the Blood

“I am the LORD who heals you.” – Exodus 15:26 (NKJV)

“...by whose stripes you were healed.” – 1 Peter 2:24 (NKJV)

The finished work of Jesus Christ does not only include forgiveness of sins but guarantees healing for your body. Divine healing is not a bonus feature of the Christian life—it is a blood-bought right of every believer.

You are not trying to get healed—your healing was already secured at the whipping post.

Isaiah 53:5 declares:

“But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.”

Before Jesus ever went to the Cross for your sins, He endured 39 lashes on His back for your healing. In ancient times, 40 lashes were fatal. He took the brink of death specifically for your physical restoration. Why would He go through such horror if healing were not God's will?

Why Sickness Exists

Sickness entered through sin – Before the fall of man, there was no disease.

It is part of the curse of the Law – Deuteronomy 28:59-61 outlines disease as a curse. But...

Galatians 3:13 (NKJV):

“Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us...”

You’ve been redeemed! If healing is part of the curse reversal, then it is part of your inheritance.

Why Don’t All Believers Experience Healing?

Legal Right vs. Manifestation

Though healing is your right, it must be received by faith. Like salvation, healing is available to all, but it isn’t automatic.

Jesus died for the whole world, but not all are saved—why? Because they didn’t receive it by faith.

Likewise, you must appropriate your healing.

Page 2: Healing Is for Every Believer

The Case for Universal Healing:

Jesus never turned away a single person who came to Him for healing.

Matthew 12:15 (NKJV):

“Great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all.”

Acts 10:38 (NKJV):

“God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil...”

Sickness is oppression from Satan. Would God leave His children oppressed when Jesus came to destroy those works? (1 John 3:8)

Healing is in the New Covenant! Why would a covenant based on better promises (Hebrews 8:6) include less healing than the old one?

Jesus GAVE authority to believers to heal.

Matthew 10:8 (NKJV):

“Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.”

Spirits of Infirmity: A Hidden Culprit

Luke 13:11-13 (NKJV):

“There was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years... Jesus said, ‘Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity.’ And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight.”

Often, what appears to be physical is actually spiritual.

Half of Jesus’ healings in the Gospels were deliverances.

Arthritis, cancer, and chronic diseases often trace to spiritual roots.

Unforgiveness → Bitterness → Tormentors (Matthew 18:23–35)

Unconfessed sin → Legal rights for demons to afflict

Deliverance clears the legal ground, and healing can swiftly follow.

Paul's Thorn Is Not Sickness

Many misquote Paul's "thorn in the flesh" to justify their sickness. But 2 Corinthians 12:7 calls it a "messenger of Satan"—not a disease!

Paul even says in verse 10: "I take pleasure in infirmities... in persecutions..." These are external trials, not internal illness.

Nowhere does Scripture say Paul had a disease God refused to heal.

Page 3: How to Receive and Keep Your Healing

Step-by-Step Instructions:

☑ Know What Belongs to You

Healing is in the covenant. Know it. Declare it.

☒ Repent of Unconfessed Sin

1 John 1:9 (NKJV):

“If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us...”

☒ Forgive Those Who Hurt You

Matthew 6:15 (NKJV):

“If you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.”

☒ Receive Prayer and the Laying on of Hands

Mark 16:17–18 (NKJV):

“They will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”

☒ Use Your Authority

Speak to the problem in Jesus’ name.

Acts 3:6 (NKJV):

“In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk.”

☒ Reject the Lie That God Wants You Sick

There is not one verse in the New Testament where a believer was told to remain sick because it was God's will.

Common Blockages to Healing

Lack of faith – Matthew 9:29: “According to your faith let it be to you.”

Unforgiveness – Matthew 18:23–35

Unconfessed sin – Psalm 66:18: “If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear.”

Not knowing healing is God's will – Hosea 4:6: “My people perish for lack of knowledge.”

Spirits of infirmity – Must be cast out in Jesus' name.

🔥 Closing Prayer: A Prayer for Healing and Deliverance

Heavenly Father,

In the mighty name of Jesus Christ, I thank You for Your Word that declares, “I am the Lord who heals you.” Today I boldly come before Your throne of grace to receive mercy and healing.

Lord Jesus, I believe that by Your stripes I was healed. I lay claim to that healing right now. I speak to every organ, system, bone, blood vessel, and cell in my body—be healed in Jesus' name!

I repent for any known or unknown sin. I ask You to forgive me and cleanse me. I forgive those who have wronged me. I let go of bitterness, resentment, and grudges. I release them now, and I release myself from torment!

I bind every spirit of infirmity, every demon of disease, every generational curse of sickness—GO in the name of Jesus! You have no right to stay in my body. I command healing to flow through me now.

Holy Spirit, touch my body. Let Your healing virtue flow from the top of my head to the soles of my feet. Restore what has been damaged. Reverse what has been cursed. Break every chain and remove every affliction. I receive it by faith now.

I declare, I AM HEALED, I AM WHOLE, and I AM REDEEMED—spirit, soul, and body.

In the name of Jesus Christ,

Amen!

Now go and walk in your covenant. Speak healing. Lay hands. Stand in authority.

You are not waiting on healing—healing is waiting on you to take it!
