

## Teaching Title: "Faith That Speaks and Moves Mountains: Living the God-Kind of Faith" - Part 1

### Introduction: What Is Faith, Really?

Faith is one of the most misunderstood topics in the Christian walk. Some think faith is simply positive thinking. Others treat it like a backup plan for when all else fails. But the Word of God gives us a crystal-clear definition:

Hebrews 11:1 (NKJV):

“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.”

In simpler terms, faith is the spiritual reality of things you don't yet see with your physical eyes—but that you know are already yours because God promised them.

Let's explore faith in practical terms:

Faith is not hoping God might act—it's trusting He already has.

Faith is not denying your problem—it's denying that problem's right to stay.

Faith is the hand that reaches into the spirit realm and brings God's promises into your life.

Faith is the currency of Heaven—nothing is transacted from God to man without it.

Hebrews 11:6 (NKJV):

“But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.”

God’s entire kingdom runs on faith. It's how you're saved, how you're healed, how you receive peace, provision, and power.

### What Is the "God-Kind" of Faith?

Mark 11:22 (NKJV):

“So Jesus answered and said to them, ‘Have faith in God.’”

The Greek renders it, “Have the faith OF God,” or in other words, “Have the God-kind of faith.”

What kind of faith does God have? The kind that speaks things into existence, calls those things that are not as though they were (Romans 4:17), and never doubts the outcome.

Let’s go further with Jesus’ own teaching:

Mark 11:23 (NKJV):

“For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.”

## ✦ Three Key Actions in the God-Kind of Faith:

Speak to the Mountain – Faith talks directly to problems.

Believe in Your Heart – Faith happens in the spirit, not the head.

Confess Until It Manifests – Faith is released through persistent confession.

## 💡 Why the Emphasis on Speaking?

Jesus mentions the word “say” three times and the word “believe” only once in Mark 11:23. That’s a 3:1 ratio. Why? Because believers struggle more with saying what they believe than they do believing itself.

Proverbs 18:21 (NKJV):

“Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.”

Psalms 45:1 (NKJV):

“My tongue is the pen of a ready writer.”

Your heart is like a tablet, and your tongue is the pen. What you keep saying is what gets written on your spirit. Eventually, your spirit will manifest what’s written.

If you continuously speak fear, defeat, sickness, and lack—those things will grow in your life. But if you consistently speak God’s Word—you’ll begin to live it.

### ♡ □ **Faith Doesn’t Deny the Problem—It Denies Its Right to Stay**

Some believers think confessing faith means pretending the problem doesn’t exist. That’s not biblical faith. The God-kind of faith says:

“Yes, I see the diagnosis, but I believe what God’s Word says about healing.”

“Yes, I feel the fear, but God’s perfect love casts out fear.”

“Yes, the account is low, but my God shall supply all my needs.”

Faith doesn’t lie. It speaks a greater truth—the truth of God’s Word.

### □ **How Does the God-Kind of Faith Operate?**

Let’s look at Jesus’ teaching again:

Mark 11:24 (NKJV):

“Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.”

### ↻ **The Process of the God-Kind of Faith:**

Step 1: Ask (Pray according to God's promises)

Step 2: Believe (In your heart, not your head)

Step 3: Receive (Speak as though it's already done)

Example: Healing Confession

“Father, Your Word says in 1 Peter 2:24 that ‘by His stripes I was healed.’ I receive that healing now. I command sickness to leave my body in Jesus’ name. I declare I am whole, strong, and full of life. Thank You for my healing!”

### **What You Hear and See Shapes What You Say**

What goes in your ears and eyes eventually flows out of your mouth.

Proverbs 4:20–22 (NKJV):

“My son, give attention to my words; incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes; keep them in the midst of your heart; for they are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh.”

The more time you spend in God’s Word:

The more your mind is renewed.

The more your heart is filled with faith.

The more your mouth becomes a sword in the Spirit.

### **Practical Steps to Build and Release the God-Kind of Faith**

#### **Do These Daily:**

Read and meditate on the Word of God.

Speak the promises of God over your life.

Reject negative thoughts and replace them with scripture.

Surround yourself with faith-filled teaching and worship.

Take time to pray in the Spirit if you are Spirit-filled.

#### **Confession Becomes Possession:**

Hebrews 10:23 (NKJV):

“Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.”
